WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Must be a U.S Citizen or a permanent resident of the United States who identifies as Black or African-American.
- Must be admitted into one of Codesmith's Software Engineering Immersive programs.
- Must submit the scholarship application at least 3 weeks prior to the desired cohort start date.
- Must be at least 18 years of age at the time of enrollment.
- Must have an annual income of no more than \$50,000.
- Must provide a letter of recommendation.
- Must have no prior employment, whether part-time or full-time, as a web developer, software engineer, or similar role.

WHERE DO I START?

- Submit your <u>online application</u> to your preferred Software Engineering Immersive program.
- After getting accepted to the Immersive program, the Admissions team member will share the Black Engineers at Codesmith Scholarship application form.
- Codesmith Team will then review your application and send the Scholarship Decision
 Email prior to your desired cohort start date.



WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T RECEIVE THE BLACK ENGINEERS AT CODESMITH SCHOLARSHIP AFTER I GET ACCEPTED INTO AN IMMERSIVE PROGRAM? ARE THERE ANY OTHER FINANCING OPPORTUNITIES?

- Apply to Codesmith's **Minorities in Tech Scholarship** offered to those who identify as Black, Latinx, Pacific Islander, and Native American.
- Explore Codesmith's financing options, including the **Black Engineers Deferred Payment Agreement** (DPA). This DPA option allows residents to complete their time at Codesmith and then pay back the tuition, interest free, beginning 180 days after graduation or 60 days after accepting a job.
